



Setting the Record Straight:

Campaign Ad Misrepresents Stellar Pro-Life Record Of Representative Travis Moore

COLUMBIA, S.C. – (Monday, May 28, 2024) A reprehensible attack which completely mischaracterizes the stellar pro-life record of Representative Travis Moore has come to the attention of South Carolina Citizens for Life. **We must set the record straight.** Travis Moore is 100 percent pro-life.

Representative Moore has a 100 percent pro-life voting record. He returned a 100 percent pro-life survey to South Carolina Citizens for Life in which he upholds the SCCL position *on every crucial pro-life issue* that the South Carolina House of Representatives has established in the past and will consider in the future now that the U.S. Supreme Court has overturned the lethal and unjust Roe v. Wade decision.
